

2025 LETS READ Promote Truth, Refute Falsehood Competition

Grade 9-10 Digital Video Rubric

Using any video generation/editing tool of choice, participants will create a digital video clip that reflects the theme of “**Articulating the Truth– Perception in the Media vs Reality.**” In particular, they will choose a misconception/perception that is prevalent in media/society about Islam. They will then identify the Truth and reality and refute that misconception using a short video of 3 -5 minutes. Format: They say ... But the Truth is ... Here is the proof.

Content, Structure & Flow (10 points)	Presents authentic data, evidence, analysis, exceptionally well with a coherent flow and structure	Presents data, evidence, analysis, acceptably well with an understandable flow and structure	Shows less than average level of effort in the content, structure & flow	Very poorly thought-out content, structure, and flow
